Thank you for allowing your daughter to play summer basketball! This letter is to let you know what to expect for the month of June 2023. Below is a breakdown of the summer:

COST:

OPEN GYM:

• We will be having open gyms every Wednesday evening at the high school. These will be half practice to prepare for the upcoming tournament, and half 5-on-5 games. These are highly recommended, especially if you plan on attending the tournament that weekend. We take summer basketball very seriously, and though we plan to have a ton of fun, we also want to offer an elite experience and prepare for the season in November.

TOURNAMENTS:

SUMMER WEIGHTS

o There will be a time block in the morning where the weight room will be open for your athlete to work on strength, speed, and agility. These are put on by the high school's strength program, and though they are not affiliated with the basketball program, we highly recommend your athlete attend as many workouts as possible to get stronger for the season.
